Ansaldo Energia: a new success in Russia worth 70 million Euro

Ansaldo Energia, a Finmeccanica company and a leader in the supply of components and services for power generation plants, has won another important contract in Russia with Stroytransgaz, a company controlled by Gazprom.

The contract – the fourth in a row that the company signs in Russia - is worth approximately 70 million Euro. More than 215 million Euro is the total value of the contracts that Ansaldo Energia has signed in the country in 2007.

This agreement is for the supply of three V64.3A gas turbines, including generators and auxiliary systems, for the combined cycle plants of Yugo-Zapadnaya TEZ, South West of Saint Petersburg. The contract also includes the provision of the main spare parts.
