Finmeccanica signs up to the Italian Ministry for Public Administration's E-gov 2012 Plan

Memorandum of Understanding signed by Hon. Renato Brunetta, Italian Minister for Public Administration and Innovation, and Pier Francesco Guarguaglini, Chairman and CEO of Finmeccanica

The Italian Minister for Public Administration and Innovation, Renato Brunetta, has today signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Chairman and CEO of Finmeccanica, Pier Francesco Guarguaglini, to implement a programme of initiatives to provide advanced services for companies and workers. The MoU forms part of the e-gov 2012 plan, which is intended to make public administration more efficient.

Under the agreement, Finmeccanica will promote public administration services within Group companies and employees as part of the "Reti amiche – on the job" project. The aim of the programme is to allow employees of Finmeccanica companies, and indeed the companies themselves, to make use of public administration services directly from the place of work or via Internet connections provided by the companies, on the basis of agreements between the administrative bodies offering the services, including the Italian Social Security Agency (INPS), local authorities and local health authorities (ASL), and the Finmeccanica Group companies.

The MoU signed today has a term of three years. The initiatives will be monitored and inspected by CNIPA (the Italian authority for information technologies in public administration) on behalf of the ministry for public administration and innovation, and by Finmeccanica SpA on behalf of the Finmeccanica Group companies.
